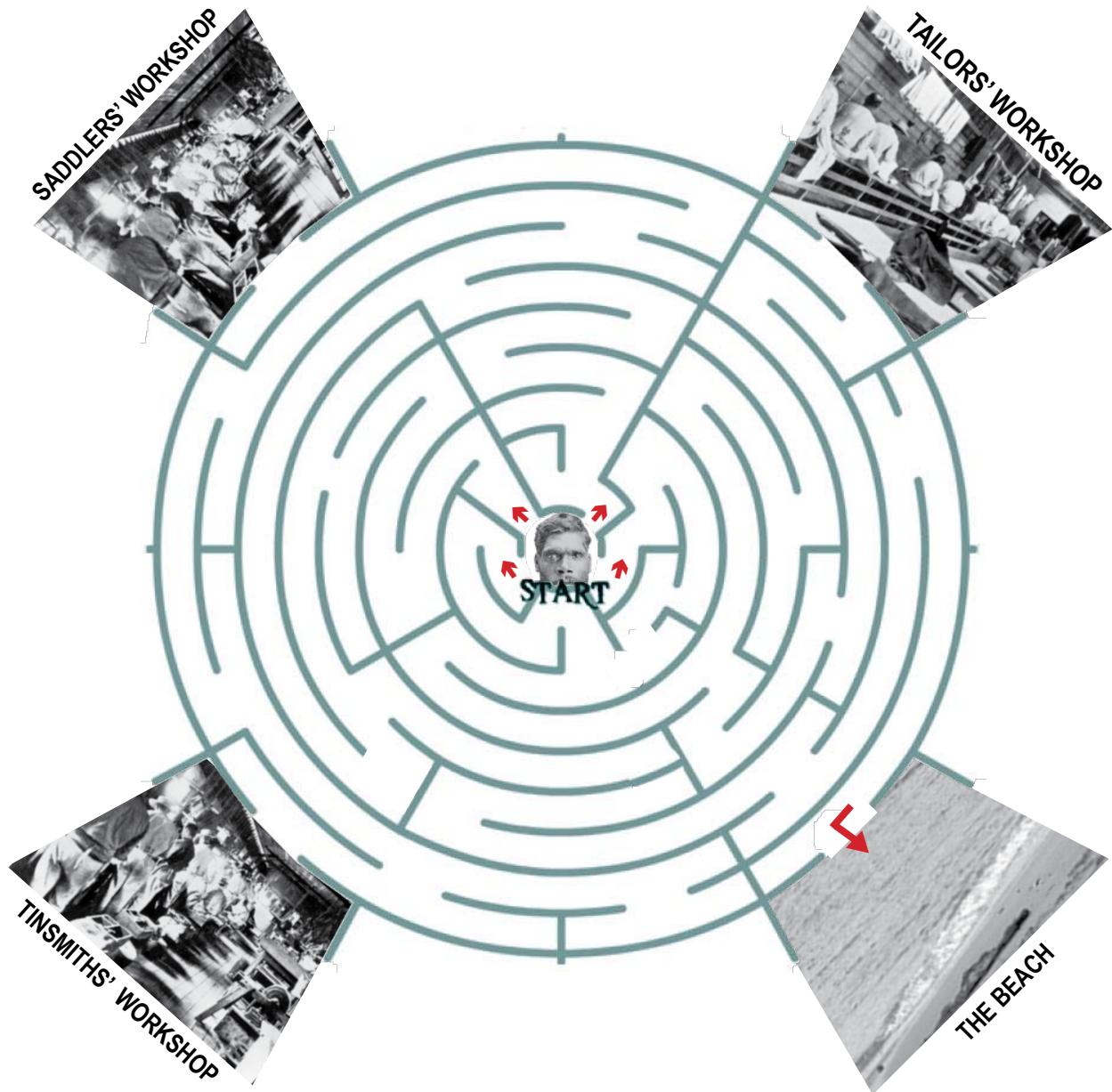


WORK - OR THE BEACH?
